PLAYER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Age Group – a player's age group for season 2010 is determined by the age he turns in 2010 ie. a player who turns 9 in 2010 is U9, a player who turns 10 in 2010 is U10, and so on.
- A separate registration form must be completed for each player and payment must accompany the form.
- The club strongly encourages parents to consider providing private health insurance for their child (ESJFC registration fee includes limited cover only).
- Registrations are accepted subject to availability of team places.
- The club communicates with players & parents predominantly via email. Please ensure your family email address is written clearly on the form.
- If you have not played with the club before you must complete this ESJFC online registration form.
- If you have not played in the MSJFL before you must complete an additional MSJFL registration form. The MSJFL form can be downloaded from www.gozebs.com. Please return completed form, and a copy of your birth certificate, to ESJFC Registrations, PO Box 77, Sandringham 3191.

REGISTRATION FEE

\$150 (first child), \$110 (each additional child).

Registration fee contributes towards:

- MSJFL competition fees, player & official insurance fees, umpire fees
- Training & game equipment including footballs, team kits, first aid kits
- Fully accredited First Aid Officer at all home ground games
- Zebbies playing guernsey for the season

- Ground & clubroom maintenance – cleaning, repairs etc
- Compulsory accreditation/training for Club Coaches
- Compulsory accreditation/training for team First Aid officers
- Zebbies website
- Team 'Pie Nights'
- MSJFL Finals levies (U11-U17)
- MSJFL Lightning Premiership fees (U9-U10), player medallions

GAME TIME/TEAM COMPOSITION POLICY

- U9 to U13 – min 3/4 game in home & away matches; min 1/2 game in Finals and Lightning Premiership matches
- U14 to U17 – min 1/2 game in all matches including finals
- Coaches are encouraged to rotate players so it is not the same players each week who play less than a full game
- Notwithstanding the above it is expected that players fulfil all necessary requirements in order to earn the right to play ie. attend training, follow team rules, behave appropriately etc.
- Composition of teams is based on friendship groups (where possible & subject to ensuring adequate numbers on all team lists), although for U13-17 the club reserves the right to organise teams so that players can be both competitive & continue to develop their football skills.

CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

All ESJFC players, parents, spectators & officials are expected to abide by the following:

- Play by the rules
- Respect and accept the decisions of officials as being fair & called to the best of their ability – do not argue with officials.
- Practice good sportsmanship – applaud the good performances of opposition teams & players as well as our own
- Be a fair winner and a good loser – understand that everyone wins & loses sometime
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Co-operate with coaches, team officials, team members and opponents – without them there would be no competition
- Be positive & encouraging – do not ridicule players for making a mistake
- Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, officials or spectators
- Any player, parent, supporter or official who brings the ESJFC into disrepute or does not abide by the club's Code of Conduct will be required to attend a meeting with the ESJFC Executive Committee and penalties ranging from warnings to suspension from attending matches or social functions and/or deregistration of any family members playing for the club may be imposed
