

**East Sandringham Junior Football Club:  
Policy Register**

The East Sandringham Junior Football Club competes in the Moorabbin Saints Junior Football League, and adheres to the AFL/MSJFL Code of Behaviour for players, coaches, officials, parents and supporters.

Consistent with its Constitution, the ESJFC General Committee from time to time implements policies in the club's best interests. This document serves as the Policy Register.

<b>Policy</b>	<b>Effect</b>
<b>Game Time Policy</b>	Between the years of Under 9 and Under 11, numbers permitting, all players will play a minimum of three quarters game time
<b>Team Size and Composition</b>	Teams will be restricted to 24 players a side unless in exceptional circumstances Teams will, subject to numbers, be based on friendship groups until Under 13 (see Grading Policy)
<b>Age Policy</b>	The East Sandringham Junior Football Club has a minimum age policy for players as follows: All players joining the club must turn a minimum eight years of age in the calendar year of their first season. Players are not permitted to play more than two seasons of Under 9 football
<b>Grading Policy</b>	From Under 9 to Under 12 inclusive, the ESJFC encourages all players to play with friends and schoolmates, subject to ensuring adequate numbers on all team lists.  From Under 13, the club reserves the right to organise teams and players to the best of its ability to provide an environment in which they can be competitive and continue to develop their football skills.
